Another option is to open up a paper shopping bag and use that.

You can use a pencil and paper plate to trace a perfect circle onto your paper before cutting. Make your hat taller or shorter by cutting a larger or smaller circle into the paper.

Paper Straw Hats We make hats from many varieties of straw and even some with recycled paper content. This material is sometimes called Toyo. The construction of these hats is either completely hand braided or sometimes it is braided into strips and then sewn together to make the hat body, then blocked into shape by steam.

Cut out the shape, decorate, then bend into the shape of a cylinder for the crown hat, or a cone for the traditional party hat and staple together. Use a hole punch to put a hole on each side of the bottom edge of the hat and tie a piece of thin elastic through them and your hat is done!

To make texture rubbings, print out the hat template on plain paper and place the paper over a textured surface such as sand paper or a woven placemat. Rub over the paper with crayon held at a slanted position. To make the hat sturdier, you can glue the paper onto cardstock before cutting out the template pieces.
