What is The Odyssey? The Odyssey is an epic poem from ancient Greece written down by the blind poet Homer around the 8th century BC. The Odyssey tells the tale of Odysseus (Ulysses in later Roman myths), a Greek war hero known as much for his metis (cleverness or cunning) as his hie (strength). It was Odysseus who supposedly created the great wooden Trojan Horse that ended the 10-year war against Troy.
