The process for ordination in the American Baptist Church is listed below: The candidate for ordination shall have completed the requirements for Tracks I, II, or III as defined in "Recommended Procedures for Ordination...as Adopted by The Ministerial Leadership Commission and the Ministers Council of American Baptist Churches USA" (PDF). The candidate should make an initial contact with the Region Minister, and maintain contact throughout the process.
